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The 4th-ranked Notre Dame MSA (*The Public Accounting Report*) is known for its quality faculty, rigorous curriculum and focus on ethics. The program builds upon students' undergraduate accounting foundation (allowing completion of the 150-credit hour CPA exam requirement) and emphasizes how accounting fits within the larger business context. Students develop industry-specific skills by selecting one of two tracks: Assurance and Advisory Services or Tax Services. Both tracks allow students to customize their MSA experience by enrolling in MBA electives, study abroad opportunities and corporate case studies. Typically, over 80% of MSA graduates begin their career at one of the Big 4 accounting firms and 99% secure full-time employment within three months of graduation.

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The Notre Dame MSM program is an 11-month cohort-style graduate business program for students with little to no work experience who graduated with non-business undergraduate degrees (science, engineering, liberal arts, etc.). Economics majors and business minors can also participate. The MSM is a full-time program that takes place across three semesters—summer, fall and spring. Through the MSM, students learn fundamental business skills in marketing, finance, accounting, management and ethics, and engage in one-on-one career coaching. In the signature "Bridge" course, students build on the knowledge they gained as undergraduates to lead to a career that fits their passions and strengths. On average, 90% of MSM students are employed within three months of graduation.

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The Notre Dame MBA is available in two formats. The one-year MBA is for professionals who have completed financial accounting and statistics courses and have an established career trajectory. The traditional two-year MBA is for professionals from any academic background and welcomes students with a variety of career backgrounds. Students experience a rigorous and well-rounded curriculum that emphasizes personal responsibility with an ethical approach to managing critical business issues. Both programs are full time and include non-traditional learning opportunities such as Interterm Intensive deep dives, international immersions and the new Integral Leadership Development program. Concentration tracks include: Business Analytics, Consulting, Corporate Finance, Innovation and Entrepreneurship, Investments, Marketing and Strategic Leadership.

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Tailored to the needs of busy executives, the Notre Dame EMBA develops students' capacity to think strategically while building the leadership skills for which Notre Dame is famous. The EMBA is offered in two formats: an 18-month program that meets biweekly in Chicago and a 22-month program that meets once a month at Notre Dame's Stayer Center for Executive Education in South Bend. In addition to a strong core of fundamental business classes, unique coursework in Executive Integral Leadership develops a leadership perspective, Design Thinking & Innovation provides new insights into markets and customers, and an international immersion project introduces EMBA students to global business. The program is designed to develop unique Notre Dame leaders—executives ready to assume the responsibility to lead with integrity, to impact lives and to serve a greater good.

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The Notre Dame EMNA is tailored to the needs of professionals already working in the nonprofit sector. In this hybrid 42-credit hour program, students gain a solid business education and acquire insights and strategies to elevate organizations into more effective and sustainable forces for good. The flexible program structure allows students to complete the degree in as little as two years or up to four years, depending on each student's summer availability. Each cohort invests a total of 10 weeks over two to four summers and develops a tight bond fostered by shared experiences and the collective desire to influence transformative change. Students work alongside peers who all have the same desire to "do something."

Through the program, students are equipped with advanced techniques in data analytics and decision science. Students develop expertise in areas such as data mining and visualization, statistics, modeling, optimization and simulation on data sets—all of which impact the operations, finance and marketing decisions for companies across industries. Through a capstone experiential consulting opportunity, students work with live data and an actual client's business challenge.

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The Notre Dame MSF program is a one-year program designed for actively employed financial professionals that takes place on alternating Fridays and Saturdays on the Notre Dame Michigan Avenue campus in Chicago. Students learn corporate financial analysis and reporting, working capital management and asset utilization to improve financing the firm. Candidates also develop expertise in M&A, investing and markets, equity valuation and derivatives. Because ethics play such a large role in the curriculum, MSF candidates are well prepared to address ethical challenges associated with risk management, compliance and international finance. Through a capstone experiential consulting opportunity, students identify the financial levers of an actual client's business challenge.
