ACCOUNTANCY MINOR

The 15-credit minor for non-business majors provides foundational accounting analytical skills through a curriculum that includes core accountancy courses and electives in data analytics, federal taxation and strategic cost management.

MASTER OF SCIENCE IN ACCOUNTANCY

Accountancy majors with AP credits can earn their BBA and MSA in just four-and-a-half years. MSA offers two tracks: **Assurance Advisory Services** for career interests in public accounting, corporate finance or with a financial institution; or **Tax Services** for interests in business enterprises or government agencies, as well as public accounting.

The **Tax Assistance Program** is a two-credit course that provides students with the opportunity to hone their knowledge of tax preparation while serving the local community. Students work directly with low-income residents on the preparation of federal and state tax returns, helping to ensure that families receive their much-needed refunds.
